Calving Ease Score ★★★★

We have put a column in with a CE Score with 1, 2, 3 or 4 stars. 1 star being harder calving and 4 stars being the easiest caving. It is just our opinion of what you could expect taking into consideration the BW, EPDs, pedigree and structure of the bull.

Semen Interest

Eichacker Simmentals will retain ¼ revenue sharing semen interest in all ES bulls selling and & JK Angus will retain 1/3 revenue sharing semen interest in all JK bulls selling. This means if we would like to collect semen on the bull for our own use, we would have the option to do so. Also, if semen is sold ES would retain ¼ revenue from the ES bulls and JK would retain 1/3 revenue from the JK bulls. The new owners of the bulls will have full possession and full salvage value.

Adjusted Scrotal

Actual scrotal measurements were taken on 1/26/22, then adjusted to a year of age using each breed's own formula for adjusted scrotal measurements.

Weight Per Day of Age (WDA)

WDA is the weight of a bull on 1/26/22 divided by the days of age.

141 Day Weight (PWG)

The 141 day gain was the average daily gain from the weaning weight until

A homozygous black bull when mated to any black cows will give you a black calf. A heterozygous black bull carries a red gene, but when mated to black cows will give you a black calf unless your black cow carries a red gene. Then you have a slight chance of getting a red calf, but neither will sire gray calves on black cows.

The A110 is not content just hitting singles to get on base. She continues to swing for the fence much like Barry Bonds. Actually they have a lot in common, with the help of some drugs they've been very successful, in A110's case it's through embryo transfer. What a set of bulls these brothers and maternal brothers are. I spent a fair amount of time evaluating them and may be more confused now than ever. Two months ago, we didn't think the TJ Chief bull, JA110-1, could hold a candle to the others, he's a month younger than the others but is sure coming on strong. I expect him to be even closer by sale day. The next two, JA110-2 & JA110-3, are full brothers to ES Right Time who is one of the most exciting young bulls in the breed. Many acclaimed cattlemen say he's one of the best footed Simmental bulls they have ever been around. I'm certainly not claiming either of these two are better than ES Right Time, but they are definitely worth your time and consideration. Then we have the four Progressive sons. Two are solid black, one is a blaze face, and the other is a brockle face. When Progressive semen became available almost two years ago our A110 cow was set up to flush and we thought "why not". If he's going to work, let's use our best cow. All seven of these bulls have something to offer, a couple are absolute beasts and a couple are very eye appealing, attractive bulls. They are all in the upper end of the charts for WDA or PWG (post weaning gain). Some are higher on one chart and then the others rank higher on the other chart. All are very sound footed which comes from their mother and the maternal side should be solid as well. Even around them every day it's amazing how they are changing, it will be exciting to see your opinion on sale day.





This trio of bulls offers a great opportunity to tie some brothers or ½ brothers together. Naturally there are some differences. The red bull, JE78, is the natural calf of the E78 cow, on paper he's the performance bull ratioing 113 for WW then 108 for YW, all around solid bull. Then the two black full brothers sired by the \$180,000 Fort Knox bull, they are very similar in type and kind being moderate in size with plenty of base width and rib shape. As with many families the glue that holds them together is their mother, E78, she was a heifer that Adam showed back in 2018. She may never have won a banner but was always in the top 2 or 3 of the class. The judges' comments were always consistent, she may be the best cow down the road and from a structure standpoint she is sound and moves as well as any animal out here.
